- Prove societal relevance: create a basis of support in society (e.g. grant awarding institutes, politicians, tax payers)
- Moral duty of helping interested non-experts along
- Professional honor: improve the image of science/scientists
- Inspiring a new generation

Why should YOU engage in public outreach

- You gain more insight about your research area when you explain it to non-experts
- It reminds you how much you love science
- On your CV, it shows that you are a good communicator with a broader view than only your research
- You meet interesting people outside your daily world
- It is fun!



Public outreach at the astronomy department

- Telescope tours for diverse groups
- Open star gazing evenings
- Pre-University College, HOVO (life-long learning), teacher training
- Public talks, lectures, master classes, etc
- Interviews (radio, tv, newspapers, magazines)
- Writing popular articles
- Help for high school students (e.g. profielwerkstukken)
- Twitter

Open star gazing evenings

- Every last Friday of the month in winter
- In cooperation with the AKN (Astronomische Kring Nijmegen)
- 60 300 visitors per evening, depending on weather
